

## Working Group application process in Switzerland

Applications to join a Working Group go through the national delegates of the associated Steering Committees (SC). The Swiss SC delegate examines your application and forwards it, if suitable in his opinion, with his recommendation to the chair of the Working Group. The Chair of the Working Group decides on the admission. Please note that at most one member per country can join a specific Working Group, so if the Chair receives several applications from the same country, he can accept no more than one of them. The best point in time to join a working group is usually in the initial “call for expert” phase while a Working Group is created, or then in the first half of the lifetime of a Working Group. The typical Working Group lifetime is about three to six years, so within the first two to three years an application makes normally still sense if you can contribute relevant knowledge and experience.
